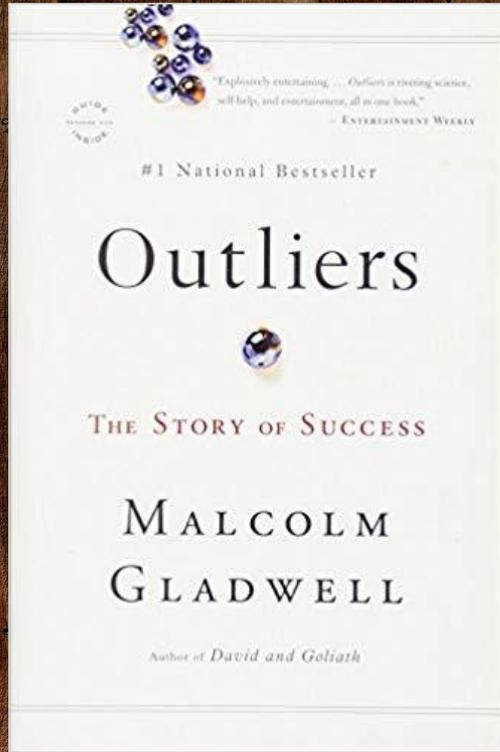

RAPID SKILL ACQUISITION

- **DECIDING** exactly what you want to be able to do.
- **DECONSTRUCTING** a skill into the smallest possible units.
- **LEARNING** enough about each subskill to be able to practice intelligently and self-correct during practice.
- **REMOVING** physical, mental, and emotional barriers that get in the way of practice.
- **PRACTICING** the most important subskills for at least twenty hours.

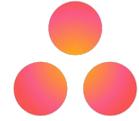
COMMON LEARNING BARRIERS

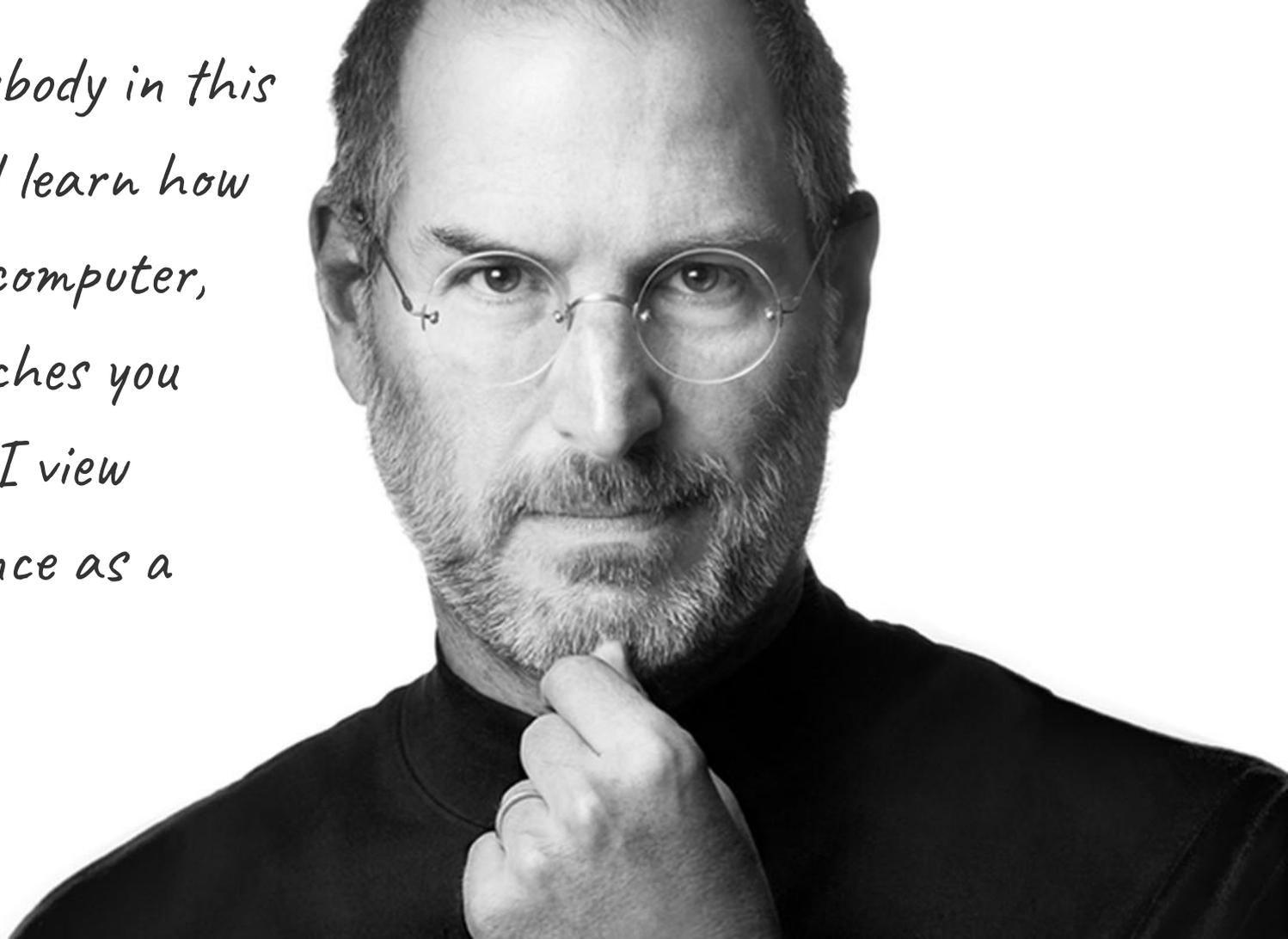

REMOVING DISTRACTIONS

- Significant pre practice effort
- Critical tools availability
- Physical distractions

- Acquiring a new skill requires giving up things we like to do
- Must align with our goals
- Plan your day
- Talk with your family
- Talk with work

PERFECTION IS OUR ENEMY

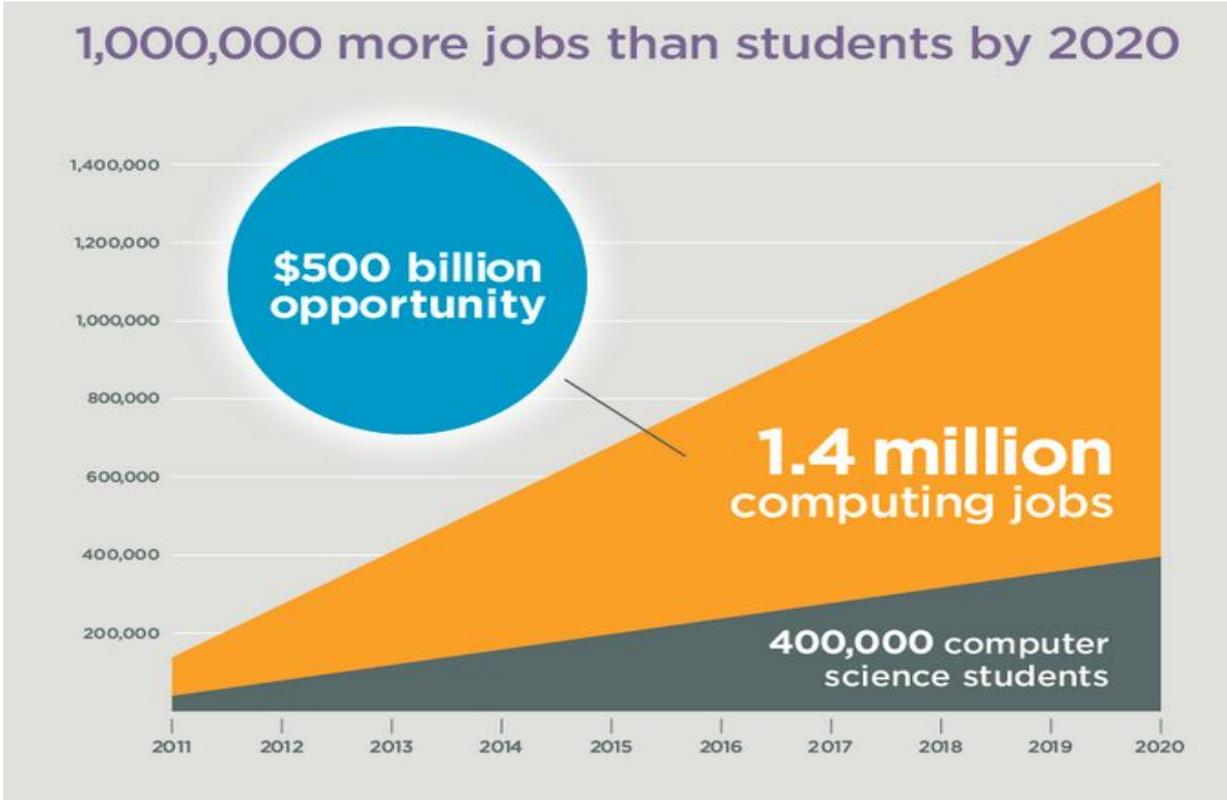
- The first day of school

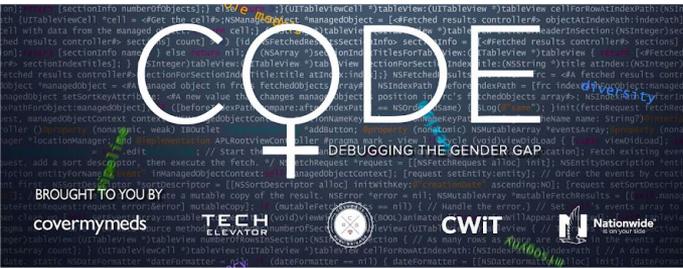
